Anna is fully qualified in Myers-Briggs Type Indicator, DiSC and also works with the LSI 360 profile.

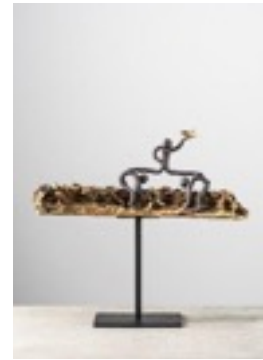
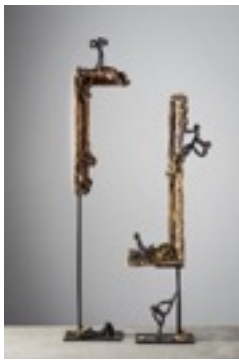
Anna’s business coaching acumen is built on a long career in the performing arts, both as a performer and a coach.
